Pollution Liability Insurance for Storage Tanks

Underwriting guidelines require a *copy* of the following documents before the application can be considered for coverage:

1. TCEQ Delivery or Registration Certificate or the TCEQ self-certification form.
2. One report for each of the last 3 months of continuous leak detection for the tanks. This will be either from the Automatic Tank Gauge System or Statistical Inventory Reconciliation or Soil Vapor Monitoring Wells.
3. Daily Inventory Reconciliation worksheet.
4. Line and Line Leak Detector test dated within the last 12 months, if the lines are pressurized.
5. Suction Line test dated within the last 3 years if the lines are suction. If the suction lines are exempt from testing, please include documentation verifying that exemption.
6. Corrosion Protection. If the tanks or lines are steel, a Cathodic Protection re-certification inspection report dated with the last 3 years.
7. If available, a Minimum Site Assessment report, Soil Sampling results or a due diligence report stating the physical condition of the property regarding pollution. If pollution is being remediated at this time, a copy of the most recent report submitted to TCEQ.
